### Board Schedule:

#### Stall only – owner of horse feeds own hay and cleans stall daily\*

\$125 per month      \$30 per week      \$5 per day (24 hours)

#### Stall & Feeding – owner of horse provides hay, we feed 2 or 3 times per day (your preference) and owner cleans stall daily\*

\$155 per month      \$36 per week      \$6 per day (24 hours)

#### Stall & Feed – we provide hay and feed 2 or 3 times per day (your preference), owner cleans stall daily\*

\$205 per month      \$48 per week      \$7 per day (24 hours)

#### Full Care – we provide hay and feed 2 or 3 times per day (your preference), we clean at least once per day

\$250 per month      \$58 per week      \$9 per day

Please ask about pasture rates.

\* If you opt to clean your own stall, it must be done on a daily basis. If stall is not cleaned by 6pm each day, we will clean it for you and charge \$5 for every day we must do the cleaning.

Monthly payments are pre-paid on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month and are considered late if payment is received after the 5<sup>th</sup>. Weekly rates are due the first day of arrival and every 7<sup>th</sup> day following with no grace period. Late fees are \$5 per day, for every day the payment is late.

### RULES:

- ALL dogs must be kept on leash at all times.
- If you smoke, pick up your butts and throw them away.
- Do not leave any horses in the arena unattended. If you leave the grounds, put your horse away.
- Riders take precedence over turn-outs in any arena.
- If you clean your own stall, bedding is not provided. If we are cleaning your stall for you, then you may not add bedding. If you feel your horse does not have enough bedding, please bring it to our attention and we will take care of it.
- **For non-boarders, arena fee is \$10 per day per horse.** There is a pay-box located halfway down the aisle on a post near the indoor entrance to the arena.
- If the front gate was open when you drove through it, leave it open. If it was closed when you drove through it (ok, you had to open it first) close it behind you.
- Proof that all shots are up to date is required for boarding.
- All injuries or illnesses to any animal must be promptly seen to by either the owner or a Veterinarian. If your horse becomes ill or injured when you are not here, every attempt will be made to contact you. If contact cannot be made, a Veterinarian will be called at the horse-owners' expense.
- *Have fun and let us know what you want to see happen here! (Playdays, team pennings, schooling shows, clinics, etc.)*
