Base price for Stall and Paddock \$125/mo

Feed owners hay \$30

RULES – please initial any space except those that do not apply:

_____ Turn-outs may only be used when owner is present. Horses may not be left in turn-outs unattended.

_____ Turn-out is allowed in any arena. However, riders or lunging take precedence over turn-outs at all times.

_____ If the gate is closed and/or locked when you arrive, please close it and/or lock it after you drive through. Please do not give out the gate-code to anyone.

_____ Stalls must be cleaned DAILY. Occasionally, I will clean your stall for you for no charge if you call me no later than 3pm to let me know that you will not make it that day. If I do not hear from you and you do not arrive to clean it, I will clean it the next morning and a charge of \$5 per day will apply to the next month's bill.

_____ Board is due on the 5th of each month and is late if received on the 6th or after. A late fee of \$5 per day will apply to all late payments.

_____ Please clean up after your horse anywhere on the property.

_____ Do not tie horses or ride horses in the main-barn alley-way.

_____ ALL dogs must be kept on leash at all times.

_____ If you smoke, pick up your butts and throw them away.

_____ **For non-boarders, arena fee is \$10 per day per horse.** There is a pay-box located halfway down the aisle on a post near the indoor entrance to the arena.

_____ All injuries or illnesses to any animal must be promptly seen to by either the owner or a Veterinarian. If your horse becomes ill or injured when you are not here, every attempt will be made to contact you. If contact cannot be made, a Veterinarian will be called at the horse-owners' expense.

_____ Owner's hay may be stored in the hay barn. At no time should anyone be feeding KEC hay to their horse. If KEC is feeding your horse and you are planning to be away from the property for one or more feedings, please get the required amount of hay for your trip from Maria.

_____ Do not borrow tack from anyone without their permission.

_____ A halter should be left on the stall door or the pasture gate for your horse, in case of emergency.
